Dear Parent/Guardian,

We at ECP are extremely pleased to offer another exciting theatre experience for children and youth this summer. There will be lots of learning and lots of fun.

Meet our director, Polly Ludena:

Polly Ludena moved to the upstate from the Chicagoland area. She holds a Masters in Education and is a South Carolina certified Theatre and Art teacher. She has an extensive performance resume and has directed and taught theatre classes at the elementary, middle, and high school levels; and the Park District in the Chicagoland area. Locally, Polly has taught camps at Electric City Playhouse and Project Challenge Playhouse. She teaches art at McCants Middle School.

Tuition fees cover:

1. 10 days of camp (Monday through Friday, June 17-28, 2019)
 - a. Rising Kindergarten – grade 5; 9am-noon & Rising grades 6-9; 9am to 3pm
 - b. **Friday June 28 Schedule:** All camper dress rehearsal 9 am – noon; all released at noon and return for performance call at 6 pm with performance at 7 pm
 - c. **Saturday June 29 Schedule:** Performance call at 9 am; performance at 10 am
2. Two performances: Friday June 28 @ 7 pm; Saturday June 29 @ 10 am
3. CD recording of the songs in the production (1 per family)
4. Summer camp t-shirt
5. Mid-morning snacks (be sure to indicate any restrictions or allergies on registration form)
6. 2 complimentary tickets per camper for a performance

Please note:

1. During camp, please
 - a. Wear comfortable clothing (older clothing preferred as we will be doing crafts) and non-skid shoes (no sandals)
 - b. Full day campers bring a sack lunch
 - c. Parents must sign Rising k-5 campers in and out each day; Rising 6-9 campers will sign selves in and out as long as an ECP volunteer sees the parent on the premises
2. Based on sponsorships received, a limited number of scholarships will be available for families meeting low-income eligibility requirements (guidelines available)
3. Children/youth need black bottoms (tights, leotards, sweatpants, trousers, etc.) for dress rehearsal and performance costumes
4. **Be sure to reserve seats early for one or both performances** as tickets go on sale to the public June 1, 2019
5. **Follow what is happening during camp:**
