Concession Worker's Duties

Please be at the theatre one hour prior to performance, 6:30 pm for evening performances and 2:00pm for matinees. The House Manager will give you a badge to wear. Please make sure you return the badge to the House Manager before you leave the theatre.

Concessions are served prior to the performance and at intermission.

Available in the concessions area will be at least one red wine, one white wine, a light beer, a cola, a diet cola, a clear soda, bottled water, as well as snacks (e.g. chips and candy) Additionally available may be a variety of other wines, regular beer, coffee (with sugar and creamer).

Upon receipt of the envelope of change ensure the counting is correct. As the play begins, place the starting change and donations in the envelope and return to the House Manager until intermission. As intermission concludes, ensure concessions monies (initial change and the evening's donations), are placed in the original envelope and returned to the House Manager.

If running low on supplies during a performance contact the House Manager who will obtain more supplies from the office area. At close of intermission check supplies and let the House Manager know of any that are running low.

A person volunteering as a Concession Stand Worker will receive one complimentary ticket for the evening/matinee show that he/she is working, provided that seats are available. On the occasion that seats are needed for paying customers, the worker will be offered a complimentary ticket for another show in the same run, if seats are available. In such case the volunteer would have to come to the theatre and would be given a seat at 10 minutes prior to production time when available; reserved seats are not available until that time.
