In alignment with both the Mission and Vision of Electric City Playhouse, ECP will provide a summer theatre experience for children and youth.

ECP Bylaws ARTICLE II. Purpose

Section 1. Mission Statement

To provide a variety of entertaining, quality experiences to a diverse spectrum of the community and surrounding areas; and to partner with other community organizations in our growth, outreach, and education of the arts.

Section 2. Vision

To operate a theatre facility where quality theatre opportunities are created through the efforts and talents of community members.

Summer Theatre Camp will

- take place the last two full weeks of June, avoiding the long 4th of July weekend, and
- generally be provided for children and youth ages 6 through 14, taking into consideration the licensing agreement parameters.

Process:

- The President in collaboration with the Production Committee Chairperson will be responsible for locating and confirming a Summer Camp Director.
- Based on input from the Board and the community-at-large, these three persons will determine the production focus for the camp and preferred titles of youth shows/musicals.
- The Office Manager will assist in gathering information on rights, royalties, and availability of preferred titles for the camp.
- The focus/title will be determined no later than October of the year prior to camp taking place. If possible, such will be determined in time to share the information with the campers and parents/guardians at the end of the previous year's camp experience.
- The budget will be determined by the President and the Production Committee Chairperson based on previous years' budgets, fees, and financial outcomes.
- Sponsorships for the camp and for scholarships for those families meeting poverty guidelines will be solicited through regular avenues.
